TROPHY HOLDERS RESPONSIBILITIES (September 2013)

- The Association winning the tournament retains the trophy in its possession until the next time the tournament is held, and is responsible for sending the trophy to the next venue.
- The Association is responsible for the trophy while it is in their possession and is responsible for the cost to repair any damage that may occur while the trophy is in their possession.
- The Association/Secretary is to keep the trophy in a safe secure place. The trophy is not to be “shared around the team members”.
- If a trophy is lost while in the possession of an association that association is responsible for the cost of the replacement trophy. The NZHF will choose the replacement trophy.
- The Association is responsible for arranging and the cost of getting their name and year engraved on the trophy.
