FIH Academy Level 3 Coaching course

A National Association may nominate a maximum of 2 coaches by the closing date, 4th of August.

Please find the course information below.

Who: Coaches working with top national adult hockey players and assisting teams at top national and also international competitions. Ideally* applicants will be a Head Coach of an Age Group team (top 16 nations) or Senior team (top 24 nations). Minimum of 5 years at a top national performance level (in past 10 years). Preference will be given to applicants with experience as a lead coach responsible for the development and mentoring of lower level coaches. Candidates should hold an FIH Academy Level 2 Coach certificate or equivalent.

**In exceptional circumstances, coaches with international club coaching experience will also be considered*

When: 09:00 3rd September to the evening of the 6th September 2019. Candidates are expected to arrive at the designated course Hotel in the evening of the 2nd September

Where: Rockhampton, Queensland, Australia. Further details will be provided to selected candidates

What: The course will be a combination of trainer and candidate led contemporary classroom and practical sessions and Oceania Cup match analysis

Cost: \$200 AUD per candidate. This includes: Lunch and Coffee Breaks from 3rd to 6th September 2019, Tournament official reception on 3rd at 5:30pm included, course materials and entry to Oceania Cup Matches

Accommodation and transport: Option to purchase a package that includes full board accommodation and transport. Payment is the responsibility of the participant and it does not include flights. This information will come available once candidates are selected

Selection Process: Applications will be considered by the course selection panel. The panel will select the most experienced and qualified applicants. The applicant's nationality will also be considered, with an aim to give the course international universality. As part of the wider Women in Hockey initiative, we will give preference to female coaches. Candidates will be notified on the outcome of their decision by 9 August. Applicants should be an independent B2+ English speaker.

Assessment process: Candidates will be formally assessed against Level 3 Coaching competencies, as well as their readiness to attend a future FIH High Performance (Level 4) Coaching Course.

Course outcome: At the end of this course candidates will have achieved one of three outcomes:

- FIH Academy Level 3 certificate with recommendation to FIH Academy High Performance (Level 4) Coaching Course, if they are assessed as Excellent at this course
- FIH Academy Level 3 Coach certificate, if they are assessed as Competent at this course
- Participation certificate, for all other situations.
