

PREVIOUS FEDERATION CUP SECONDARY SCHOOLGIRL TOURNAMENT WINNERS

The first National Secondary Schoolgirl Tournament was held in May 1980 in Palmerston North with Eastern Southland the winner of the Manawatu Sportnews Trophy. Four more were held but with the formation of the New Zealand Secondary Schoolgirls Hockey Advisory Board this tournament was changed.

The inaugural tournament was held in Wellington May 1985 on the artificial surface and recognised representative secondary schoolgirls with 12 teams. Meanwhile during this time the secondary school tournaments continued but seedings were introduced after the formation of NZHF.

Mr Tom Leigh donated a trophy. He had been the Secretary of the Secondary committee and was a leader in the development of these tournaments. The Leigh Trophy was played for the next seven years and by this time the NZ Hockey Federation was established.

A decision to change to the Federation Cup in 1996 was the fitting with the introduction of the elite secondary competition, celebrating the improved Youth programme and acknowledging the linking of youth hockey in the New Zealand Hockey Federation.
